



Standards of Conduct for Coaches

- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my players ahead of my own desire to win.
- I will treat each member of my team as individuals, value all players equally and coach talented and less talented players with equal vigor.
- I will lead by example in demonstrating fair play, respect and sportsmanship to all my players, referees, parents and spectators.
- I will coach clean, skillful and honest soccer.
- I will not address remarks to opposing players, referees, coaches or other spectators. This doesn't include genuine remarks of friendship, apology or acknowledgement of excellent play.
- I will treat the referees with respect, avoid degrading remarks and use the appropriate channels if complaints are necessary.
- I will do my best to provide a safe and appropriate environment for for my players during any NCSC sponsored event.
- Other than on game days, after 24 hours, and practice times, in front other players, I will listen to feedback from parents and players.
- I will inform the NCSC Office if questions, concerns or issues arise that I am unable or uncomfortable addressing. I will treat confidential matters as such.
